As part of our **New Creatives 2025/26** programme, we're inviting schools to take part in a dynamic creative workshop or assembly session designed to spark creativity and explore climate action.



About the New Creatives Programme

New Creatives is a free, annual programme for young people aged 14–24 in Peterborough, running weekly during term time from September to May. It offers a welcoming space to develop creative skills, collaborate with professional artists, and make a positive environmental impact. Young people can sign up for one term at a time.

Two pathways for 2025/26:

- Youth Programme (Ages 14–19) – For those curious about creativity, performance, and environmental storytelling
- Young Leaders Programme (Ages 20–24) – For emerging creatives looking to build facilitation and leadership skills by supporting younger participants

Key Details:

- When: Available July and September 2025
- For: Key Stage 3 and Key Stage 4 students
- Where: Delivered in schools

We are currently offering free in-school sessions to introduce students to the New Creatives programme. Schools may choose from the following:

Eco-Games Workshop

A high-energy, 45–60 minute workshop using theatre and game design to explore environmental topics in a fun and accessible way. Led by our current New Creatives group and professional facilitators, the session includes:

- The Eco Gameshow – A team-based, quiz-style challenge about climate and sustainability
- Carbon Cycle Game – A physical activity exploring how carbon moves through natural and human systems

- Mini Games and Creative Challenges – Movement-based activities exploring waste, community action, and climate solutions

AND/OR

Assembly Presentation

A short, engaging introduction to New Creatives and wider youth opportunities with Jumped Up Theatre, designed to inspire students aged 14–19.
